The all-inclusive fee is R39 100.00 (VAT incl.)

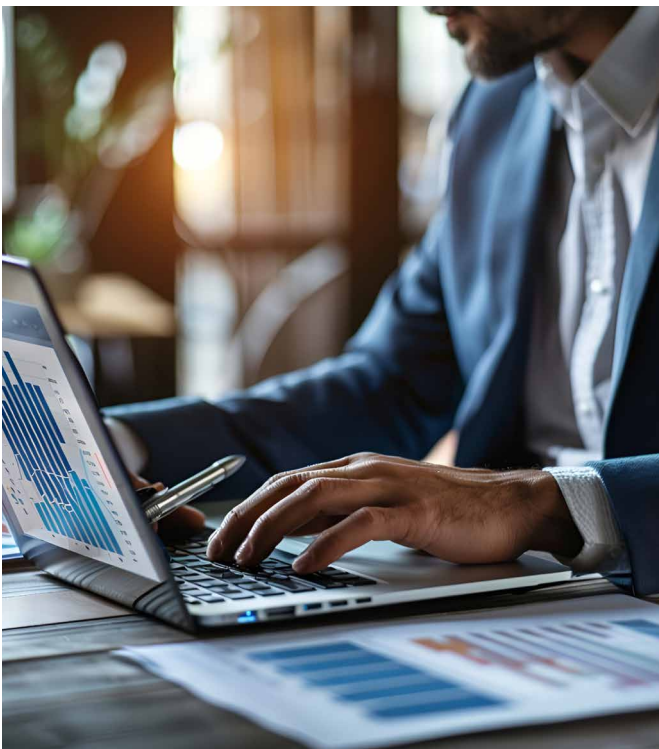
