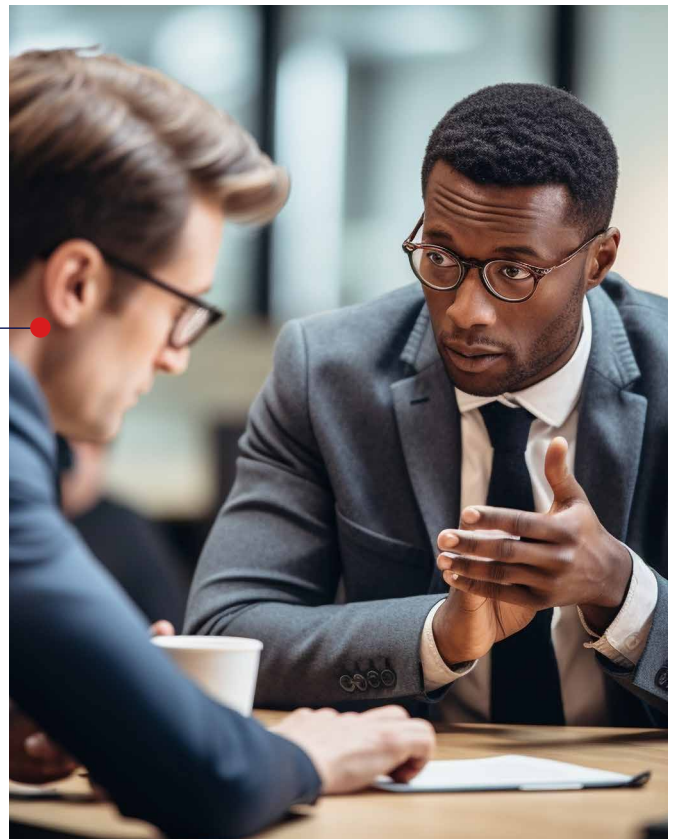

The course has no prerequisites but eligibility to write the exam and gain certification is strictly prescribed. The prerequisites to becoming PMP® certified are:

- ✓ A four-year degree, 36 months leading projects, and 35 hours of project management education/training (PPM or equivalent) or CAPM® Certification

- OR -

- ✓ A Grade 12 certificate or the global equivalent, 60 months leading projects and 35 hours of project management education/training (PPM or equivalent) or CAPM® Certification. Delegates are advised to book to write the exam 1–2 months after the course. This must be done through the PMI at www.pmi.org
